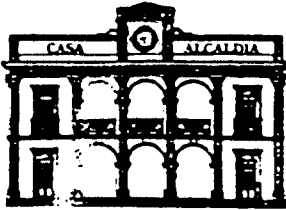




SUBJECT: Housing Opportunities for Persons with
Aids (HOPWA) Competitive

The Notice of Fund Availability (NOFA) for subject program was published in the Federal Register on February 16, 1995. It announces the availability of \$19,200,000 to fund projects for low-income persons with HIV/AIDS and their families under the following two categories of assistance:

1. Grants for special projects of national significance which, due to their innovative nature of their potential for replication, are likely to serve as effective models in addressing the needs of eligible persons.

Eligible applicants under this category are States and units of general local government, regardless of whether they qualify for a HOPWA formula allocation and non-profit organizations.

2. Grants for projects which are part of long-term comprehensive strategies for providing housing and related services for eligible persons.

However, the Government of Puerto Rico, units of general local government and non-profit organizations are not eligible to apply for the second category of grants.

Application deadline is April 17, 1995. Only timely applications will be considered for funding. To be considered timely, the application must be received by 6:00 PM Eastern Time at the following address:
